Enroll in NIFDI Distance Learning Webinars!

Is your school using a distance learning model this Fall? With schools shut down due to the COVID-19 pandemic, NIFDI is meeting the needs of educators by offering two webinars that will assist in understanding the considerations for delivering Direct Instruction in a variety of methods, such as live presentation via Zoom (or other platforms), pre-recorded lessons, and packets of material for students to work through.

On July 21, we will offer a webinar for those teaching Reading Mastery Signature Edition Reading K and 1. The 90 minute session will contain specific information about tasks that must be modified for live, virtual instruction and also look at effective techniques for checking for mastery of material presented in recorded lessons. Plan to Attend the NIFDI Virtual Direct Instruction Conference!

NIFDI was forced to cancel the National Direct Instruction Conference, but there will still be some virtual trainings this summer. During the week of July 28-31, NIFDI will host 4 virtual training sessions:

NIFDI Announces Online Preservices!

NIFDI is offering online preservice training sessions on select programs during the week of August 3-6. These preservices will provide participants with most of the critical skills and content they need to start to deliver the DI programs effectively in the fall.

Program trainings include:

Morning Sessions (8:00am-10:30am, Pacific)

- Reading Mastery Signature Edition Grade K Reading
- Reading Mastery Signature Edition Grade 1 Reading
- Corrective Reading Decoding Level A

Afternoon Sessions (12:00noon-2:30, Pacific)

- Reading Mastery Signature Edition Grade K Language
- Reading Mastery Signature Edition Grade 1 Language
- Corrective Reading Decoding Level B1, B2 and C

In order to facilitate mastery of skills, we are limiting group size to no more than 12 participants per session. After receiving group instruction, attendees will break into small groups for practice and feedback from our highly skilled presenters. Participants will have the opportunity to demonstrate their mastery of skills and earn a certificate of proficiency.

Another unique feature is the availability of "office hours." Each day, for 30 minutes after the morning and afternoon sessions, participants can sign up for time with their trainer to meet individually or in small groups to work on further skill development.

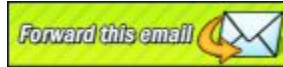
Participants in these preservices will be contacted about follow-up trainings during the school year
